Healthy Families Program

The Osborn Community and Wayne/Macomb Counties

What is the Healthy Families Program?

Healthy Families is a program that promotes positive parenting and child health development, thereby preventing child abuse and other poor childhood outcomes. Services are voluntary and are available to families with a pregnant member or with a child under 47 months of age living in Wayne or Macomb counties and families with children from 0-18 years of age in the Osborn community living in zip codes 48205 or 48224 and is designed to support overburdened families. Home visits focus on improving parenting skills, child development, child health, preventative health and other aspects of family functioning.

The program not only provides access to services but resources as well. By participating in the program families can receive items such as:

Who is eligible for the Healthy Families Program?

If you are a resident in the Osborn Community living in the zip codes of 48205 or 48224 with a child(ren) up to age 18 you may qualify.

If you are a resident of Wayne or Macomb county, pregnant or have a child(ren) under 47 months of age, you may qualify.

Once enrolled you will receive weekly home visitation from an experienced outreach worker who will offer you personal support while exploring needed resources identified by the family to help promote a healthy living environment. You will learn techniques to build stronger relationships with all members of your family unit. Additionally, the outreach worker will provide **information and referral services** to assist the family with:

- Housing
- Employment
- Transportation
- Food
- Health Insurance
- Counseling Services
